Promoting Britishness

- In promoting Britishness, we promote practice in understanding, acceptance and tolerance of all cultures and faiths
- o Children are encouraged to make rules, debate, vote and choose
- Our snack time is set in a family setting with children and staff sitting together at the table
- o Our staff encourage that the children use the correct English language

Anti-Radicalisation

- o This starts with the recruitment and continued suitability of staff
- We do not allow staff or visitors to the site to discuss personal religious or idealistic views with the children in our care
- We ensure that staff do not spend one on one time with vulnerable children away from the main group

Anti-Extremism

We ensure staff are vigilant and are aware of signs exhibited by pupils or colleagues which may indicate extremist views, staff are instructed to report directly to the child welfare officer or site manager.

- A pupil or staff member displaying or expressing extremist actions or views or materials of others inside or outside of our setting
- Graffiti symbols, writing or art work promoting extremist messages or images
- Any changes in behaviour, friendship or actions over a period of time or after a period of absences from the setting
- o Expressions of intolerance to difference, whether it be religious, gender, disability or sexuality
