ISOLATION CLARIFICATION

I am writing to clarify our procedure regarding the need to self-isolate.

As you will be aware the bubbling system is one of a number of measures implemented and devised to enable schools, businesses and society to function whilst protecting and limiting the spread of the virus and harm to individuals and the wider community. Due to the number attending after school childcare club, we are bubbling in year groups.

We have now completed our first half term under the new restrictions, and I'm delighted to confirm the children have adapted to the changes effortlessly respecting the zoning system we have in place.

We are continuously monitoring and assessing our procedures and as such, we have now revised our Isolation Policy due to the fact that natural friendship groups have developed within all our year groups, with children choosing to sit next to and play with the same friends.

This has enabled us to reclassify the criteria for self-isolation, should this be necessary.

If a child who attends after school childcare club has to self-isolate along with their class, their friendship group at childcare will also be asked to self-isolate, this will not affect the rest of the year group.

If your child is required to self-isolate at short notice, you must collect immediately. Failure to do so will result in your child's place at childcare being cancelled.

As set out in our terms and conditions, we do not refund or credit for cancelled or missed days, please note this also includes self-isolation: this is to protect the company and its ability to continue to trade and offer a vital service through these difficult times.
